Public open days

The Centre is open to the public on the third Sunday of every month, February through to November, **9am – 3pm**.

We do not hold public open days in December and January. It is advised you bring a completed application form with you, which is available for download on the website under 'visit the centre'. Please note public open day admission to the RAAF Base ceases at 2:30pm

Visiting Schools and Groups

Schools and community groups can visit the Heritage Centre between **9am – 3pm** on Tuesdays and Thursdays, **strictly by appointment**.

RAAF Base Amberley is a secure base and visiting groups are to plan their visit inclusive of arrival together on a minibus, bus or coach.

Bookings are essential.

Location

RAAF Base Amberley, Southern Amberley Road, 40kms south-west of Brisbane, on the outskirts of Ipswich.

Take the Centenary Highway to Yamanto, then follow the Cunningham Highway to the RAAF Base Amberley turnoff to the right, at Willowbank.

Visitors aged 16 years and over are required to produce photographic ID issued by a State or Commonwealth authority. While assistance dogs are accommodated, pets are not permitted on the RAAF Base at any time.

Access and Security

As we are located within the Base secure zone, admission to the base is tightly controlled through visual and recording of all ID checks. We advise that during busy times this may result in access delays. Dash cams are to be turned off and put away while on the Base.

RAAF Base Amberley's Aviation Heritage Centre is a not-for-profit, must-see attraction for everyone visiting south-east Queensland, especially military aviation history enthusiasts.

Opened in June 2011, the Heritage Centre has a range of exhibits and displays with a collection of aircraft including World War II Boston Bomber, courtesy of the Papua New Guinea Government, a Vietnam-era Canberra bomber, Caribou airlifter, Sabre and Mirage fighter jets, F-111, Macchi, Sioux and Iroquois helicopters, and an immaculate WWII jeep.

From time to time we have RAAF Amberley's operational aircraft on display and special guests such as the Amberley Brass Band, vintage car clubs or fly-in visits from restored warbirds and special interest aircraft.

The Heritage Centre, currently housed across three display hangars, is growing as more aircraft and artefacts are restored, loaned or donated for display.

The Aviation Heritage Centre is run by a team of Reservists & supported by dedicated local volunteers from the Ipswich and Brisbane communities

- each with a keen interest in military aviation history, and in particular that of South East Queensland.

When you visit our Centre, those same dedicated people will tell you about each display and the story behind it and we hope that these amazing stories get passed on from generation to generation.
